The City of Fort Collins is hosting a public information open house from 5 to 7 p.m. Monday, February 13, at the Lincoln Center, 417 W. Magnolia St.

According to the city's press release, the open house will provide information on a proposal by City of Fort Collins staff to "explore the potential for negotiated outcomes with Northern Water."

### **Fort Collins City Council to vote on proposed resolution - February 21**

Following the open house the council will discuss and hopefully approve a resolution that authorizes Fort Collins staff to meet on a regular basis with Northern Water "to discuss and explore the City's and Northern Water's mutual interests in order to ascertain whether those interests can be met... [on] issues related to NISP."

This will occur at the council's regularly-scheduled meeting on Tuesday, February 21. Meetings begin at 6 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall West, 300 LaPorte Ave.
