





- 3 6"X6" SINGULAR COBBLE ROCKS; ROCKS WITH SMALL GROOVES AND HOLES SERVE AS A WATER SOURCE FOR
- 4 NATIVE PERENNIALS 50% OF PLANTS PROVIDED IN POLLINATOR GARDENS
- 5 NATIVE ORNAMENTAL GRASSES 35% OF PLANTS PROVIDED IN POLLINATOR **GARDENS**
- 6 NATIVE SHRUBS 15% OF PLANTS PROVIDED IN POLLINATOR GARDENS

1. A MINIMUM OF 65% OF THE TOTAL POLLINATOR GARDEN AREA IS TO BE COVERED WITH PLANTS AT PLANT MATURITY. (SYMBOLS

2. POLLINATOR GARDENS SHOULD BE MAINTAINED PESTICIDE AND HERBICIDE FREE. REFER TO SITES, SECTION 8, OPERATIONS +

3. A MINIMUM OF 1 WATER SOURCE, (ROCK COBBLE) IS REQUIRED EVERY 500SF WITHIN POLLINATOR GARDENS.
