



- NOTES:
1. A MINIMUM OF 65% OF THE TOTAL POLLINATOR GARDEN AREA IS TO BE COVERED WITH PLANTS AT PLANT MATURITY. (SYMBOLS SHOWN REPRESENT FULL PLANT MATURITY.)
 2. POLLINATOR GARDENS SHOULD BE MAINTAINED PESTICIDE AND HERBICIDE FREE. REFER TO SITES, SECTION 8, OPERATIONS + MAINTENANCE (O+M C8.4), FOR POLLINATOR GARDEN MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES.
 3. A MINIMUM OF 1 WATER SOURCE, (ROCK COBBLE) IS REQUIRED EVERY 500SF WITHIN POLLINATOR GARDENS.

- 1 NATIVE SEED, PRIMARY GROUND COVER MATERIAL FOR POLLINATOR GARDENS. REFER TO LANDSCAPE PLANS FOR SEED MIX AND APPLICATION RATES
- 2 BARE EARTH - 10% OF TOTAL POLLINATOR GARDEN AREA. (NO WEED BARRIER OR MULCH IN THIS AREA. AREA TO BE MAINTAINED FREE OF WEEDS)
- 3 6"X6" SINGULAR COBBLE ROCKS; ROCKS WITH SMALL GROOVES AND HOLES SERVE AS A WATER SOURCE FOR POLLINATORS
- 4 NATIVE PERENNIALS - 50% OF PLANTS PROVIDED IN POLLINATOR GARDENS
- 5 NATIVE ORNAMENTAL GRASSES - 35% OF PLANTS PROVIDED IN POLLINATOR GARDENS
- 6 NATIVE SHRUBS - 15% OF PLANTS PROVIDED IN POLLINATOR GARDENS
