The Sustainable Landscape Management (SLM) foundation is simple – applying the right maintenance practices at the right time. The program consists of a manual outlining sustainable landscape management principles and practices and a training class. Completion of the 4-hour training class and a passing score on the exam following the class earns you the Sustainable Landscape Management certificate.

The SLM Certificate Program will...

- Level the playing field for all maintenance providers by using the same standards
- Educate the public on what proper maintenance looks like
