3. Unit costs are based on industry knowledge and recent pricing of Colorado Front Range landscape projects.
4. Excluded costs that may also be incurred: Landscape contractor design and installation service, material delivery fees, Permit fees, lighting and electrical work, gas service to fire features, handrails and guardrails, furnishings, sheds, planter pots, waste disposal.
