

Native Grass Establishment In Progress

Native grasses reduce the need for irrigation, mowing and chemical treatments, while also providing beneficial habitat for a variety of pollinators, birds and other species.

Establishing native grasses is a multi-year process, which includes:

- Soil preparation, seeding and germination
- Seed establishment and weed control
- Potential over-seeding

Allowing native grasses to grow and produce seed heads will benefit grass health.
